Please review these behavioral guidelines with your child and be sure that he/she understands them. The parent and camper are required to sign the bottom of the page to show that you are in agreement with the following terms.

My Child will adhere to the following rules:

- Be respectful to peers and adults.
- Use appropriate language.
- Keep hands and feet to yourself.
- Avoid touching and taking other children's items.
- Treat all camp toys, items and property respectfully.
- Avoid behavior that may jeopardize the health and safety of themselves or others.
- Help keep our camp clean and orderly.
- Speak kindly to others and avoid hurting feelings.

Consequences of Inappropriate Behavior in Order:

1. Verbal warning.
2. Loss of privilege for specific activity.
3. Loss of field trip.
4. Meeting with parents and camp director regarding consequences of behavior.
5. Suspension from camp for predetermined length of time.
6. Expulsion from camp.

Simple problems will be treated with re-direction by the staff. Camp counselors are trained in positive reinforcement, redirection, and developmentally appropriate behavior management skills. Fighting, stealing, destruction of property, and behavior that may jeopardize the health and safety of themselves or others may directly result in expulsion.
